## Activity 6: Learning with and from Others – Participating in a Tweet Chat

### Participatory Activity - CPD Activity

Now, visit <http://wecommunities.org/tweet-chats/chat-calendar> to look at the chat calendar.




Choose your chat!

After participating in the tweet chat take some time to reflect on your experience. Within 24 hours a transcript of the chat and a summary will be available. The following questions might be helpful:

- What stands out for you in the key messages of the tweet chat?
- What is the importance/significance of this for you?
- What have you learnt from the tweet chat?
- What do you need/want to know more about?
- What actions should you take now?
- What might be the consequences of these actions for you and others?

You will probably find it helpful to make some notes and to write down your actions so that you can revisit them at a later date. Your notes could be included in a portfolio as evidence of your CPD activity.
